A must-visit for all collectors of glassware, Lobmeyr's third store has been in Kärntner Strasse since 1895. For six generations, this family-run business has been famed for crafting the most exquisite of glass objects, including chandeliers for opera houses. Ranging in style from the classic to the contemporary, Lobmeyr's drinking services, vases, decanters and more are pure in form. The candy dish (above) is a

1925 piece by Oswald Haerdtl (see p031), the Viennese architect and designer who worked with the firm in the 20th century; it was reissued in 2016 in a supersized and obliterated form.
