Nothing can elevate the simple routine of drinking water to a pleasurable, almost ceremonial experience any better than Lobmeyr's carafe and beakers, which were designed in 1952 by Hans Harald Rath. The drinking set No 267 comes in muslin glass – crystal that is blown to a thickness of less than a millimetre yet is surprisingly robust. If 2018 is the year that you give up buying plastic water bottles then you may find that the set has paid for itself by the end of January. *From £111 for the carafe and £32 per beaker; lobmeyr.com*

Camilla Elphick's shoes are made by hand at the designer's studio in Chelsea and a family-run factory in Parabiago, Milan. Despite only graduating from the London College of Fashion four years ago, 28-year-old Elphick has become popular with industry insiders for her designs that fuse craftsmanship with tongue-in-cheek personality (a pair of courts with heels moulded to look like Pez packets were snapped up instantly). Her Silver Lining boots, which feature an arrow on the back, have developed a cult following among fashion editors and this season come in Christmas-appropriate red metallic leather. The best bit?
