Suspensions

Standard types

Suspending a chandelier is always a crucial issue in regards of the overall impression in the room. For public areas there are many exterior requirements which make each project special. For private residences we follow some guidelines which we have proven to produce the best outcome: The chandelier should be suspended as low as possible and at least 20 cm from the ceiling.

Suspensions in detail (from left to right):

Rod: Simplest and most gentle suspension. All wires are inside the pipe. It comes in a finish matching the chandelier and can not be adjusted on site.

Chain: Easiest way when it is necessary to adjust the height on site and comes in a finish matching the chandelier. Wires are threaded through the links and become a stylistic element.

Silk Rope: All technical elements such as a steel rope and the wires are covered by silk. This allows adjustment on site by about 5 cm. Available in various colours.

Upon request custom suspensions can be offered. (divided rods, various canopy alternatives,...)
